The mission of Communities In Schools of Cape Fear is to surround students with a community of support, empowering them to stay in school and achieve in life

We place staff directly inside targeted, high-need public schools to work with vulnerable students and those with the greatest risk of dropping out of school. Our Student Support Specialists provide targeted interventions and link students and their families with resources including tutoring, attendance monitoring, mental health counseling, mentoring, and afterschool programs.

Our unique model works because it's based on national research, driven by community relationships, and supported by local resources.

- A chance to give back to peers and community.




Our Story in 2 Minutes

The goal of Communities In Schools is to surround students with a community of support providing the resources needed for them to stay in school and achieve in life. We do that by placing student support specialists directly in 29 targeted schools across New Hanover and Pender counties.

Student Support Specialists provide interventions to students struggling with attendance, behavior or academic coursework. Student Support Specialists build relationships with their students, surrounding them with a network of trust they can turn to no matter where they are in their journey. CIS also provides whole- school supports like free school supplies, resource fairs, and crisis intervention services. Last year, CIS served more than 19,000 students in the Cape Fear - that's enough people to sell out Live Oak Bank Pavilion nearly three times over!

CIS also offers free afterschool, summer camps, programs for young parents, and diversion programs aimed to keep low level offenders out of the juvenile justice system - all to accomplish the wider goal to empower students to unlock their full potential.


Interact with our Students

Wrightsville Plunge: January 1, 2024


