Last year, in North Carolina, 51 students dropped out of school every school day.



Students who drop out are at increased risk of being chronically unemployed and relying on government assistance; they face high rates of incarceration and are six times more likely to become a young parent. Dropping out of school affects the future of our children and the future of our area's economy and ability to compete in a global workforce.
