## Roles & Responsibilities

1

### SCHOOL Referral

- School refers parent
- School provides work to student

2

### PARENT Registration

- Parent calls 910-343-1901 (extension 112)
- Parent gathers student work and information regarding the student's suspension

3

### PROGRAM Orientation

- Parent and student attend 30 minute orientation on first day of the program

4

### PROGRAM OSS Services

- Program provides a healthy environment focusing on student behavior, mental health, and completion of school work

5

### ALL School Re-entry

- Parent, student & school personnel meet to plan a successful re-entry into school
- Student is referred to Communities In Schools for continued support as appropriate

**3-10** DAYS

Student must have their own transportation
