To fulfill our mission, we place staff directly inside 29 targeted, high-need public schools, who work with vulnerable students and those with the greatest risk of dropping out throughout the school day.

Students who drop out are at increased risk of being chronically unemployed and relying on government assistance; they face high rates of incarceration and are six times more likely to become a young parent.
