The mission of Communities In Schools of Cape Fear is to surround students with a community of support, empowering them to stay in school and achieve in life. To fulfill our mission, we place staff directly inside 33 targeted, high-need public schools, who work with vulnerable students and those with the greatest risk of dropping out throughout the school day.

Our unique model works because it's based on national research, driven by community relationships, and supported by local resources.

Last school year, we provided free programming and support to 34,549 students, 2,664 of those received ongoing, case-managed support.

Why get involved

Last year, in North Carolina, 51 students dropped out of school every school day.



Students who drop out are at increased risk of being chronically unemployed and relying on government assistance; they face high rates of incarceration and are six times more likely to become a young parent. Dropping out of school affects the future of our children and the future of our area's economy and ability to compete in a global workforce.

CIS provides integrated student support services, exposure to academic and career opportunities, and access to resources—all designed to ensure students stay in school and are empowered to achieve in life.
